A public meeting for the draft was held February 21st in the EARPDC 3rd floor conference room. There was a total of 9 attendees not counting EARPDC staff. While the public comment period has ended, maps of proposed projects can still be found

on the MPO website (<u>Calhoun Area MPO</u>). At this time, we are wrapping up a finalized document from comments given from local ALDOT and each MPO municipality to submit to ALDOT and FHWA for review.

FY 20-23 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

The MPO is responsible for adopting a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which presents a 4-year program for improvements in the various transportation systems located within the Calhoun Area Transportation Study.

All municipality TAC members have been notified of a hard deadline of April 1st to submit potential MPO projects. These projects will be reviewed and prioritized at the April 17th TAC meeting.  STPOA-0021(543) for constructing the Traffic Signal Improvements (Traffic Signs, Traffic Signals, and Traffic Stripe) on SR-21 (McClellan Boulevard) at the intersection of Lenlock Lane in Anniston. The Bracket Estimate on this project is from \$150,930 to \$184,471.

Upcoming Funding Opportunities & Deadlines

It's not too early to be thinking ahead!

- ➤ The Economic Development Administration (EDA) is now accepting applications for the 2019 Regional Innovation Strategies (RIS) Program which offers funding through 2 competitions.
 - **FY19 i6 Challenge –** awards up to \$750,000 for projects that increase regional capacity to accelerate the translation of innovations, ideas, intellectual property, and research into products, services, companies, and jobs.
 - FY19 Seed Fund Support (SFS) Grant Competition provides up to \$300,000 for projects that create, launch, or expand equity-based seed funds or that create networks and tools that enable capital to flow into high-growth startups in all parts of the U.S.

Deadline to apply is April 4, 2019.

- ➤ The USDA Rural Development, **Community Connect Program**, is accepting applications for grants to establish broadband infrastructure in unserved rural communities. Awardees must also use their USDA funding to offer free broadband service to all critical community facilities and a community center in their proposed service area for two years. The minimum grant amount is \$100,000; the maximum is \$3 million. Applicants must be able to prove a 15% match on the desired grant amount. **Deadline to apply is April 5, 2019.**
- The ARC will begin accepting applications for the 2019 round of the **Partnership for Opportunity** and **Workforce and Economic Revitalization (POWER)** initiative on February 1 and are due no later than **April 10, 2019**. Approximately \$45 million will be awarded through this competitive grant process. The POWER initiative will continue focusing on regional investments that maximize economic revitalization in the Appalachian region's coal-impacted communities.
- ➤ The USDA **ReConect** program will offer up to \$600 million nationwide in loans and grants to help build broadband infrastructure in rural areas. Projects funded through this initiative must serve communities with fewer than 20,000 people that have no broadband service or where existing service is slower than 10 megabits per second (mbps) download and 1 mbps upload. To qualify, projects must increase access speeds to at least 25 mbps upload and 3 mbps download. Priority will be given to projects that propose to deliver higher-capacity connections to rural homes, businesses, and farms. Applications for grant funding are due by **April 29, 2019**, for loan and grant funding by **May 29, 2019**, and for loan funding by **June 28, 2019**.

➤ The USDA Rural Development is accepting applications for grants to use broadband technology to improve access to healthcare and educational services in rural communities through its **Distance Learning and Telemedicine (DLT) Grant Program**. Grants range from \$50,000 to \$500,000 and can be used to finance telecommunication equipment, computer networks, and advanced technologies to support job training, academic instruction, or access to specialized medical care in rural areas. The application deadline is **May 15, 2019**.

More information on deadlines will be distributed as it becomes available.
