The meeting was called to order at 10:07 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

There were no new attendees when called to order.

OLD BUSINESS:

Minutes of the CAC meeting from January 15, 2020, were approved on a motion by Mr. Tim Huddleston and seconded by Mr. Bruce Britton. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick called for discussion of February, March, and April Administrative Modifications and Resolutions. Ms. Libby Messick explained that there was a list of modifications in the agenda packet to review that were discussed during the month of December to keep the members of the CAC up to date. There were 4 modifications that created changes to the TIP and one modification that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet in February. There was 1 modification that created changes to the TIP and three modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet in March. There were no modifications that created changes to the TIP and two modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet in April. Ms. Messick also stated that there were 3 resolutions adopted during February and 2 resolutions adopted in April, which was also given to the members for review.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Update and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects and reviewed the Administrative Modifications for the month. Ms. Messick explained that there was one

modification that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and one modification that did not create any changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 803. The resolution was requested by the ALDOT that the MPO allocate an additional \$126,902.12 in CN for project number 4, Baltzell Gate Signal Upgrade (100047014). This resolution would bring the total allocated amount for this project to \$453,734.12. A motion was made by Mr. Bruce Britton to approve this request with **Resolution No. 803**, which was seconded by Mr. James Jenkins. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Ms. Messick explained that there was a list of current construction projects in the agenda packet and briefly reviewed it with them.

Next, Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. She gave the committee updates on item numbers 13, 15, 19, 20, and 8. For item number 13, she explained that this project would be added under the LRTP. For item number 15 she explained she needed to update this response as the TAP application due date had passed. For item number 19, she asked for confirmation on the intersection of concern. Mr. Tim Huddleston confirmed that it was the 431/SR-21 intersection. This item will be updated and discussed at the next TAC meeting. Ms. Messick explained the newest item, number 20 and explained that previous signalization of this intersection had been denied due to the proximity to other signalized intersections. This matter would be further discussed with Mayor Smith and local ALDOT, Shane Brown. She further explained that item number 8 had been moved to the closed section as the speed limit increase had been approved by Oxford City Council February 11 and new speed limit signs had been installed. Mr. Reuben Johnson brought forth a timing issue with the left turn signal at south bound Quintard and 10th street. He stated that the timing felt very short for this light and asked for it to be investigated. Mr. Tim Huddleston also asked to investigate other options for this intersection such as increasing lane length.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for discussion of CAC vacancies. Anniston has 6 vacancies, Oxford has 5, Jacksonville and Calhoun County have 1 vacancy each. An additional handout with each member and attendance percentage for the previous year was also listed.

Ms. Messick called for the report on Anniston Express and ADA Para-Transit Ridership. Ms. Messick stated that the last two pages in the agenda pack are graphs to review and explained that there were 4,285 passengers on the Fixed-Route which was a drastic decrease from the previous month and from the previous year due to COVID-19 restrictions. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of April. There were 771 trips for the City of Anniston (decrease), 104 trips for the City of Jacksonville (decrease), 57 trips for the City of

Weaver (decrease), 161 trips for the City of Oxford (increase), 64 trips for the Urbanized part of the County (decrease) and 60 trips for the Rural part of the County (decrease).

The next CAC meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, July 15, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. in the EARPDC 3rd floor Conference Room. If social distancing protocols are still in place, the meeting will be held via teleconference.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:42 a.m.
