After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Vice Chairman Jenkins called the meeting to order at 10:09 a.m.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the November 18, 2021 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Toby Bennington and seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Vice Chairman Jenkins called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP. Ms. Messick explained that there was one administrative modification for the month that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and no administrative modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Vice Chairman Jenkins called for discussion of Resolution No. 829. Ms. Messick explained this resolution is to add Project Number 100073971 Access Management on SR-21 from 0.71 Mile North of the SR-1 (US-431) Overpass in Anniston to George Douthit Drive in Jacksonville to the STIP/TIP. This project would not include any MPO funds but would need to be in the MPO's TIP as it is in the MPO area. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 829**, which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.

Vice Chairman Jenkins then called for discussion of Resolution No. 830. Ms. Messick explained this resolution is for annual updates to ALDOT's Safety Performance Measures. She further explained this resolution is to support these measures through the MPO's projects. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 830**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Vice Chairman Jenkins next called for discussion CAC Appointments. Ms. Messick reported that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston needs 9 appointments, 1 for the City of Jacksonville, 1 for Calhoun County, 7 for the City of Oxford, 1 for the City of Weaver, and 1 for Hobson City.

Next, Vice Chairman Jenkins continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Mr. Mark Stephens reported for item #26 the mayor has called a meeting with the police chief to discuss this concern.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Vice Chairman Jenkins called for the status report on other local projects from ALDOT East Central Division. Mr. Shane Brown had sent a report for the current construction projects. This report detailed the US-431 access management project was working on punch list items. The SR-21/Baltzell and SR-21/Lenlock projects are working on punch list items and awaiting final acceptance. The Church Ave project is finishing up permanent stripe and completing punch list items. The US-78 resurfacing project is placing permanent stripe and working on punch list items. The I-20 resurfacing project is awaiting permanent stripe and punch list completion. AL-9 resurfacing has had wearing surface completed from double bridges to Natures Trail. This project has been winterized due to seasonal limitations and should restart in March/April.

Vice Chairman Jenkins called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick explained the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 571 (decrease) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 125 (decrease) one-way trips, 16 trips for Weaver increase), and Oxford had 160 (increase) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 89 (decrease) one-way trips and 125 (increase) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 7,745 (increase) riders for the month of December.

Finally, Vice Chairman Jenkins called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees. There were none.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 am. The next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, February 17 at 10:00 a.m.
