After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Chairman Clendenning called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the October 21, 2021 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Toby Bennington and seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

The minutes of the November 4, 2021 called meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Fred Denney and seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Clendenning called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP. Ms. Messick explained that there were eight administrative modifications for the month that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and one administrative modification that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Chairman Clendenning next called for discussion CAC Appointments. Ms. Messick reported that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston needs 9 appointments, 1 for the City of Jacksonville, 1 for Calhoun County, 7 for the City of Oxford, 1 for the City of Weaver, and 1 for Hobson City.

Next, Chairman Clendenning continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Ms. Messick called attention to item #15, narrow road/intersection Saks Rd/43rd St. The new infrastructure bill will include funding that could be used for Safe Routes for School. Mr. Toby Bennington stated he would have Mr. Branton Cole with the City of Anniston follow up on item #21. Mr. Fred Denney updated item #22, increased speed limit on the western terminus of Bynum Blvd. The study for this issue concluded that an increase in speed was not justified. This item will be moved to closed status.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Chairman Clendenning called for the status report on other local projects from ALDOT East Central Division. Mr. Shane Brown had sent a report for the current construction projects. This report detailed turnouts, turn lanes are currently being paved and concrete items are being completed for the US-431 access management project is in progress. The SR-21 signal upgrades at Baltzell and Lenlock are on punchlist items. Permanent stripe is to be placed this week along with punchlist work for the Church Ave resurfacing project. Permanent stripe is to be placed for the US-78 resurfacing from Coldwater Creek bridge to AL-21. The I-20 resurfacing project from Snow creek to the Calhoun/Cleburne line is awaiting permanent stripe and punch list completion. Wearing surface has been completed from double bridges to Natures Trail on the AL-9 resurfacing project from US-78 to close to the Nature Trail.

Chairman Clendenning called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick explained the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 613 (increase) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 118 (increase) one-way trips, 20 trips for Weaver (decrease), and Oxford had 156 (increase) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 103 (increase) one-way trips and 100 (increase) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 7,679 (decrease) riders for the month of October.

Finally, Chairman Clendenning called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees. There were none.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 am. The next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.

FY 2020 – 2023 STIP/TIP Amendments

WHEREAS, the ALDOT has requested that the following amendments be made to the FY 2020-2023 Statewide Transportation Plan (STIP) and subsequent FY 2020 – 2023 TIP for the Calhoun Area MPO to add the following project that has been placed in PLAN status:

Project Number 100073971 Access Management on SR-21 from 0.71 Mile North of the SR-1 (US-431) Overpass in Anniston to George Douthit Drive in Jacksonville

Scope: PE

Engineers Estimate: \$200,000

Development Commission

This project does not include any MPO funds.

Adoption and Support of New Statewide Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets

WHEREAS, federal regulations require that the Metropolitan Transportation Plans and Transportation Improvement Programs include Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets for urbanized areas and;

WHEREAS, the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of the Calhoun Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration and the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) has reviewed the requirement to adopt Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets for use in the transportation process as required by 23 CFR 490.105;

WHEREAS, the TAC at its January 12, 2022 meeting recommended that Calhoun Area MPO adopt and support the Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets approved by the ALDOT:

- Number of Fatalities Target: 961
- Rate of Fatalities per 100 million Miles Traveled Target: 1.400
- Number of Serious Injuries Target: 6000
- Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million Miles Traveled Target: 9.00
- Number of Combined Non-Motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries Target: 365

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Calhoun Area MPO Policy Committee hereby adopts and supports the Statewide Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets as approved by the ALDOT.
