After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Vice-Chairman, Mr. Jerry Parris called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

### OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the August 17, 2017 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Jay Jenkins and seconded by Mr. Brian Rosenbalm. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Parris called for discussion of tabled Resolution No. 746 & 748. Mr. Toby Bennington explained that the City of Anniston is still in a disagreement with ALDoT over the wording, so they requested that the two resolutions remain tabled.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Vice-Chairman Parris called for the Review of FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and MPO Projects. Mr. Humber gave the members a handout of the list of MPO projects to review. He stated that he had not received any changes since last meeting.

Vice-Chairman Parris continued by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 749 which will support the City of Jacksonville's request to reclassify Henry Road and Country Club Drive to minor collectors. Mr. Humber stated that traffic counts are being done this week on the two roads to complete the required documentation. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve **Resolution No. 749**, which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried. Mr. Humber said that once the traffic counts have been completed, he will mail all documentation to the ALDot.

Next, Vice-Chairman Parris called for the discussion of Resolution No. 750 which will add project 100066967 (FM) Federal Aid # STPAA 0021 to the FY 16-19 TIP. This project is to resurface and stripe SR-21 from north of the city limits of Jacksonville to .2 miles east of Maxwellborn Road. Mr. Steven Corley explained that this is just an addition to the TIP, this project will involve no MPO funds. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve **Resolution No. 750**, which was seconded by Mr. Toby Bennington. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Parris continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 751 which will increase the PE budget amount from \$50,000 to \$170,000 for Barry Street/US-78 Reconfigure Intersection project for the City of Oxford. Mr. Fred Denney explained that the new engineering estimate the city received is at \$170,000. A motion was made by Mr. Brian Rosenbalm to approve the increase of \$64,747 with **Resolution No. 751**, which was seconded by Mayor Johnny L. Smith. Motion carried.

## **OTHER BUSINESS:**

Vice-Chairman Parris called for the status report on other local projects from ALDoT East Central Division. Mr. Shannon Jones discussed the local projects and gave the members a handout to review. Mr. Steven Corley discussed the ALDoT sponsored projects.

Mr. Humber gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of August. There were 10,511 passengers on the Fixed-Route during August. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of August. There were 928 trips for the City of Anniston, 315 trips for the City of Jacksonville, 4 trips for the City of Weaver, 238 trips for the City of Oxford, 285 trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 231 trips for the Rural part of the County.

There being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 10:25 a.m.




