After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Chairman, Mayor, Wayne Willis called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

Chairman Willis welcomed Mr. Jim Doolin from ALDoT to the MPO.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

There was no quorum at the October 18<sup>th</sup> meeting, therefore the minutes of the September 21, 2017 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Fred Denney and seconded by Mayor Johnny L. Smith. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Chairman Willis called for the Review of FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and MPO Projects. Mr. Humber gave the members a handout of the list of MPO projects to review. He stated that he had not received any changes since last meeting. Mr. Steve Haynes stated that project #48 could be

removed from the TIP spreadsheet because it is an ALDoT sponsored project, not the MPO. He also stated that any project components that did not move forward in FY 17 needs to be moved into FY 18 with the additional 1% added to the allocation.

Chairman Willis continued by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 752. Mr. Humber stated that the County has asked to shift \$224,909 from the CN allocation on project #6 McIntosh Rd. Realignment into the CN allocation for project #44 Bynum Leatherwood/Gadsden Hwy. Intersection Improvements. This will increase the new CN allocation to \$899,909 for project #44. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to accept this shifting of funds with **Resolution No. 752**, which was seconded by Mr. Brian Rosenbalm. Motion carried.

Next, Chairman Willis called for the Report from the Citizens Advisory Committee. Mr. Dennis Reaves explained that the CAC met yesterday and the members discussed the lighting at the intersection of Bynum Blvd. and 202. They said that there was not sufficient lighting at that intersection to see the road very well and wanted to know if the lighting could be upgraded like the Bynum Leatherwood Rd. intersection. ALDot said that would be a decision for the County and the City of Oxford, but they would look into it.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

Chairman Willis called for the status report on other local projects from ALDoT East Central Division. Mr. Shannon Jones discussed the local projects and gave the members a handout to review. Mr. Steven Corley discussed the ALDoT sponsored projects.

Mr. Humber did not have the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of October.

Mr. Dennis Reaves explained to the members that the CAC is still needing representatives that will be active members to fill the open slots for each municipality.

There being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 10:24 a.m.

Next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, December 21, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.
