After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Ms. Messick called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

Ms. Herzberg from Sterling was introduced as a new guest.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the February 18, 2021 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Toby Bennington and seconded by Jay Jenkins. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Mesick called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP. Ms. Messick explained that there were no administrative modifications for the month. She further explained the amounts allocated for FY 21-23 had increased slightly due to state gas tax.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 817. She explained this resolution was to amend the 2019 Bike-Ped plan to add an Appendix D that included Trail Economic Impacts for

Calhoun County. She further explained the updated SCORP also included an economic impact, so this would better reflect that plan. Mr. Toby Bennington further explained the current and ongoing work by Jennifer Green and JSU's CEDBR. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 817**, which was seconded by Mayor McCrory. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Resolution No. 818. She explained this resolution was to amend the current FY UPWP to allocate \$160,680 in remaining funds from the previous year's UPWP. She further explained \$27,887 would be allocated to Task 6.3 which was for Anniston's Bike-Ped plan update and feasibility studies for CLT/Coldwater connectivity. The remaining funds would be placed in Task 6.2 as a catch all for any special studies that the municipalities may want to have done as well as to save for large plans such as the LRTP. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 818**, which was seconded by Mr. Jay Jenkins. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 819. She explained this resolution was to support a letter of disagreement with the recommendation to the OMB to make changes to the 2010 standards for delineating Metro and Micropolitan Statistical Areas. Ms. Messick included the letter to be submitted during the comment period and noted the major change was to denote urban areas as those with a population of 100,000 instead of the current 50,000. This had the potential to affect 7 out of 12 MPOs in Alabama. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve the letter with **Resolution No. 819**, which was seconded by Mr. Toby Bennington. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 820. She explained this resolution was to certify the FY 21 ADA Para-transit Implementation Plan Update which is a yearly update performed by ACTS. Mr. Shane Christian spoke briefly about what is included in the plan and any changes that occurred between last and this fiscal year. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve the certification with **Resolution No. 820**, which was seconded by Mr. Jay Jenkins. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion CAC Appointments. She explained that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston still needs 7 appointments, 2 for the City of Jacksonville, 7 for the City of Oxford, and 1 for the City of Weaver.

Next, Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. The only update was the City of Anniston had requested a traffic study by ALDOT for item number 21 at the intersection of 10th and South Quintard. There were no further updates.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for the status report on other local projects from ALDOT East Central Division. Mr. Shane Brown reported the bridge painting projects over railroads in Calhoun and other counties were accepted for maintenance; AL-144 resurfacing and safety widening is nearing completion and is awaiting perm stripe; US-431 access management has turn lanes and U-turn bulbs complete with median cross over removal and turn lane construction in progress; Baltzell and Lenlock materials have been approved and work should begin in 2-4 weeks; and Church Street is awaiting production of retaining wall material but should begin work May 3.

Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of February, which was provided in the agenda packet for review. Ms. Messick further explained the ADA Paratransit Ridership for December; Anniston had 563 (decrease) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 106 (increase) one-way trips, 56 trips for Weaver (decrease), and Oxford had 126 (decrease) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 82 (decrease) one-way trips and 98 (increase) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 4,773 (decrease) riders for the month of February.

Finally, Ms. Messick called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees. There were none.

Next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, April 15, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, Mr. Toby Bennington motioned to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Jay Jenkins. Motion carried. Ms. Messick adjourned the meeting at 10:35 a.m.
