After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Vice Chairman, Councilman Jeff Clendenning called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. There were no new guests.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the October 15, 2020 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Toby Bennington and seconded by Jay Jenkins. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Vice Chairman Clendenning called for the appointment of the MPO Policy Committee Chair and Vice Chair. Mayor Wayne Willis, Toby Bennington, and Fred Denney formed a committee for Committee Chair and Vice Chair nomination, vote, and appointment will occur at next month's policy meeting. Motion carried.

Chairman Clendenning called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP. Ms. Messick explained that there were two modifications that created changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Chairman Clendenning next called for discussion CAC Appointments. Ms. Messick explained that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston still needs 7 appointments, 2 for the City of Jacksonville, 7 for the City of Oxford, and 1 for the City of Weaver.

Next, Chairman Clendenning continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. There were no new updates available. Mr. Mark Stephens provided an update for item 20 that ALDOT had conducted a signal warrant study and found a signal was not warranted.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Chairman Clendenning called for the status report on other local projects from ALDOT East Central Division. Mr. Shane Brown gave a report included in the agenda packet. He detailed bridge painting projects were waiting on punch list items and on-going claims; Mountain Street was on punch list items; wearing surface and guardrail is currently being placed on the AL-144 resurfacing and widening from St. Clair County line to US 431 and the upper binder is being placed; turn lanes and u-turn bulbs are being placed through the upper binder along the north and southbound outside on the US-431 for the access management project; and SR-21 signal upgrade at Baltzell Gate and Lenlock are awaiting material submittal and approval.

Chairman Clendenning called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of September, which was provided in the agenda packet for review. There were 5,541 passengers on the Fixed-Route which was a decrease from the previous month and decrease from the previous year due to COVID-19 restrictions. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of July. There were 663 trips for the City of Anniston, 158 trips for the City of Jacksonville, 66 trips for the City of Weaver, 188 trips for the City of Oxford, 139 trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 155 trips for the Rural part of the County.

Finally, Chairman Clendenning called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees.

Next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, December 17, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, Chairman Clendenning adjourned the meeting after a motion from Mayor McCrory at 10:18 a.m.
