After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Vice-Chairman, Councilman Jeff Clendenning called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The minutes of the August 16, 2018 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mr. Fred Denney and seconded by Mayor Alberta McCrory. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for the Review of FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Libby Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP and also a list of the ALDoT modifications for this month and briefly reviewed it with them.

Next, Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for discussion of Resolution No. 766. Ms. Messick explained that this resolution will adopt the Statewide System Performance Targets (PM2), which are the Bridge and Pavement Performance Measures. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to

approve the adoption of **Resolution No. 766**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning continued by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 767. Ms. Messick explained that this resolution will adopt the Statewide System Performance Targets (PM3), which are the miles traveled by person or truck. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve the adoption of **Resolution No. 767**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Next, Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for discussion of Resolution No. 768. Ms. Messick explained that this resolution will transfer the CN allocation, \$11,822, on project #3 Resurface Chief Ladiga Trail with Sidewalk Connection to the PE allocation of the same project. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve the adoption of **Resolution No. 768**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning continued with New Business by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 769. Ms. Messick explained that this resolution will amend the Fiscal Year 2019 UPWP to transfer leftover funds from FY 2017 in the amount of \$58,517 into FY 2019 to continue the update of the 2012 Calhoun Area Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve the transfer of funds with **Resolution No. 769**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning continued by calling for the discussion of CAC Appointments. Ms. Messick explained that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston still needs 6 appointments, 4 for the City of Oxford, 1 Trucking Representative, 1 for the Anniston Army Depot, 1 for the Town of Hobson City, and 1 for the ALDoT Local Transportation Bureau. Mr. Dennis Reaves, CAC Chairman, explained to the MPO members present that at their meeting the day before, a sub-committee was formed to help get new members recruited and appointed for the districts in need.

Mr. Dennis Reaves also stated that the CAC members had some concerns with the intersection of 202 and Bynum Blvd. because of the lighting. He stated that numerous members have complained about the lighting at night because you can't see that there is an intersection there it is so dark. After a brief discussion, Mr. Fred Denney from the City of Oxford said he would look into who's responsibility it is for lighting that particular intersection.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for the status report on other local projects from ALDoT East Central Division. Mr. Shannon Jones gave a report on the local sponsored projects, which were provided as a handout for review, and Mr. Steven Corley gave an update on the ALDoT sponsored projects.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning continued by calling for an Update of the Bicycle-Pedestrian Plan Update – stakeholder meeting. Ms. Messick said that there was a flyer in the agenda packet explaining that there would be a meeting October 3<sup>rd</sup> from 3:00-4:30 p.m. in the EAC 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Conference Room for anyone that wanted to attend.

Next, Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for discussion of the MPO/RPO Newsletter. Ms. Messick explained that they were going to start doing a monthly newsletter that has MPO and RPO updates to keep everyone informed, along with a monthly calendar of meeting dates and times.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of August, which was provided in the agenda packet for review. There were 10,617 passengers on the Fixed-Route during August. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of August. There were 928 trips for the City of Anniston, 253 trips for the City of Jacksonville, 23 trips for the City of Weaver, 232 trips for the City of Oxford, 322 trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 319 trips for the Rural part of the County.

Vice-Chairman Clendenning called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees and there were none at this time.

Next meeting of the MPO will be Thursday, October 18, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Clendenning adjourned the meeting at 10:35 a.m.
