The meeting was called to order at 10:04 a.m. by Ms. Dawn Landholm. Ms. Landholm introduced Ms. Libby Messick, the new regional planner for EARPDC.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the May 9, 2018 meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Rodney McCain. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Old Business to discuss at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Landholm called for review of the FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet. Ms. Landholm gave the members a handout of the list of MPO projects and briefly reviewed the last changes with them. Members present gave Ms. Landholm changes that needed to be made on the spreadsheet as far as color shading of components and which FY some needed to be in.

Next, Ms. Landholm called for Status Report of ALDoT projects. Mr. Shannon Jones gave the members a handout of the updates on the local ALDoT sponsored projects to review. Mr. Steven Corley gave an update on the regional projects.

Ms. Landholm continued by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 761 Revised Performance Measures Agreement. This resolution was approved at last month's meeting, but a few small grammatical changes were made that were requested from the ALDoT. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this certification and present it for consideration at the next MPO meeting, which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.

Next, Ms. Agyei-Boakye continued by discussing Resolution No. 762 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment. This resolution will amend the wording

Ms. Agyei-Boakye called for discussion of Administrative Modifications. She gave the members a handout to review.

Next, Ms. Agyei-Boakye called for discussion of Update on the Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan. Ms. Dawn Landholm stated that they had submitted documentation to the ALDoT to get their list of approved contractors to update this plan.

Ms. Agyei-Boakye gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of April. There were 8,942 passengers on the Fixed-Route during April. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of April. There were 879 trips for the City of Anniston, 173 trips for the City of Jacksonville, 6 trips for the City of Weaver, 159 trips for the City of Oxford, 342 trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 333 trips for the Rural part of the County.

There being no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Mr. Rodney McCain to adjourn at 10:22 a.m., which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.
