The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the January 9, 2019 meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Michael Hosch. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Old Business to discuss at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects and also reviewed the Administrative Modifications for the month. Ms. Messick explained that there were only two modifications that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and they were listed first. The next two did not create any changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Next, Ms. Messick called for discussion of Resolution No. 776 Amend FY 19 UPWP. She explained that this will allocate the remaining administrative funds from fiscal years 2018 and 2016 in the amount of \$95,667 into FY 2019 in order to hire a consultant to update the Calhoun Are MPO Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). A motion was made by Mr. Mark Stephens to approve this request with Resolution No. 776, which was seconded by Mr. Michael Hosch. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Resolution No. 777 Adoption of the FY 19 Public Participation Plan. She explained that the MPO has provided a public comment Period of forty-five (45) days from January 3, 2019 to February 19, 2019 and there has been no comments. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve this adoption with Resolution No. 777, which was seconded by Mr. Michael Hosch. Motion carried.

Next, Ms. Messick called for discussion of Resolution No. 778 Adoption of the FY 19 ADA Para-Transit Plan Update. She explained that a review and comment period was done on January 9, 2019 and public comments were solicited through an ad in the Anniston Star on January 9, 2019, also a public review and comment meeting was held on February 12, 2019 at which no comments have been made. A motion was made by Mr. David Thompson to approve adoption with **Resolution No. 778**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for Status Report of ALDoT projects. Mr. Shannon Jones had sent in a copy of the local construction projects which was given as a handout for review, but no ALDoT representatives were present.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. It was noted that #4 needed clarification of which jurisdiction needed to request the speed study.

Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for the Update of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan. She explained that a public meeting will be held on February 21st, 4:00-6:00 p.m. and comments will be accepted for a 14-day period ending March 7, 2019.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of the FY 20-23 TIP Projects and LRTP included Projects. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the projects separated out by jurisdiction for review. She also stated that this plan is updated every five years and will forecast transportation projects for a 25-year horizon.

Ms. Messick continued by giving the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of January. There were 8,239 passengers on the Fixed-Route during January. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of January. There were 735 trips for the City of Anniston, 215 trips for the City of Jacksonville, 17 trips for the City of Weaver, 157 trips for the City of Oxford, 323 trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 234 trips for the Rural part of the County.

Friendship Road Widening and Bridge Replacement

Beginning 1600 feet west of the Friendship Rd and Cheaha Dr intersection and continuing just east of Circle Dr

Phase I: Roadway Widening STA 27+00.00 to End Project

Phase I of the project will include the widening of Friendship Road from a two lane to a three lane roadway from STA 27+00.00 to the shown End Project on the concept map. Additional items included in this Phase include the design of more functional drainage structures due to known drainage issues and more functional ditches to carry the existing water flow.

Phase II: Bridge Replacement Begin Project to STA 26+00.00

Phase II of the project will include the removal of two existing bridges: bridge 1 (STA 13+00.00 to STA 15+04.26 (204.26' long)) and bridge 2 (STA 24+02.70 to STA 25+72.67 (169.97' long)). Bridge 1 will be lengthened and bridge 2 will be replaced with a relief culvert. The longer length of bridge 1 will allow for a no rise designallowing for a more streamlined design process moving forward.

Phase III: Intersection Improvements at Friendship Road and Cheaha Drive.

Phase III will complete the overall master plan for the area by adding left and right turning lanes at the intersection of Friendship Road and Cheaha Drive from STA 20+00.00 to STA 29+00.00 and upgrading the existing signal to accommodate the additional lanes. Additional access management features have been anticipated at the corner gas station and shown on the concept as well.
