The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the March 20, 2019 meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Michael Hosch. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Old Business to discuss at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects and reviewed the Administrative Modifications for the month. Ms. Messick explained that there was only one modification that created a change on the TIP spreadsheet and it was listed first. The next five did not create any changes to the TIP spreadsheet. There was a question about project # 39's allocation on the TIP not matching what is on the modification list. Ms. Messick said she would look into it. It was stated that project #6 is under construction, #7 is complete and that #14 is in for a May letting and will be separated into two projects after it lets. Also, project #42 CN needs to be moved from FY 19 into FY 20.

Next, Ms. Messick called for discussion of Resolution No. 779 Increase CN allocation for Project #35. She explained that this request came from the ALDoT. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve this request with **Resolution No. 779**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Status Report of ALDoT projects. Mr. Shannon Jones reviewed the local construction projects which was given as a handout for review, and Mr. Steven Corley discussed the ALDoT sponsored projects.

Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for discussion of FY 20-23 TIP Projects. She explained that she had received a request from the City of Oxford for a 3-Phase Friendship Rd. Widening and Bridge Replacement project, which was given as a handout for review.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Mr. Fred Denney explained that #1 will be handled through the city without being an MPO project.

Ms. Messick continued with New Business by calling for the Update of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan. She explained that a public meeting was held on February 21st, 4:00-6:00 p.m. and comments were accepted until March 7, 2019. The final review and approval will be in May.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of the STIP Public meeting that will be held on May 16th after the MPO meeting.

Mr. Brian Rosenbalm discussed the possibility of an ATRIP 2. Applications would be accepted in November of 2019.
