The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the November 10, 2020 meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for a motion to further discuss Resolution 807: Increase funds for Russell Drive CN. A motion to approve Resolution 807 was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that there were four modifications that created changes to the TIP spreadsheet and three modifications that did not create any changes.

Next, Ms. Messick called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown gave a report included in the agenda packet. He detailed bridge painting projects were waiting on punch list items and on-going claims; Mountain Street had been accepted for maintenance; the wearing surface and shoulder stone was complete on the AL-144 resurfacing and widening from St. Clair County line to US 431 and the guardrail is in process of being installed; turn lanes and u-turn bulbs are being placed through upper binder along north and southbound outside of the 431 access management project; and SR-21 signal upgrade at Baltzell Gate and Lenlock are awaiting material submittal and approval.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. There were no new updates available.

Next, Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of October, which was provided in the agenda packet for review. There were 5,425 passengers on the Fixed-Route which was a decrease from the previous month and decrease from the previous year due to COVID-19 restrictions. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of November. There were 642 (decrease) trips for the City of Anniston, 138 (decrease) trips for the City of Jacksonville, 67 (increase) trips for the City of Weaver, 180 (decrease) trips for the City of Oxford, 97 (decrease) trips for the Urbanized part of the County and 156 (increase) trips for the Rural part of the County.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, January 13, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:16 a.m.
