### **OLD BUSINESS:**

The Anniston/Weaver/J'ville Road project is being closed out at this time and Mr. Plunk stated that there is no updated information available.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Mr. Plunk called for review of the FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and MPO projects. Mr. Plunk gave the members a handout of the list of MPO projects to review. All projects highlighted in green have been authorized to move forward by the ALDoT. The projects in yellow are the projects that have been shifted from one FY to another with the additional 1% added to the cost, projects highlighted in blue have had a recent adjustment in allocation, and the projects highlighted in pink are ATRIP or ARRA funded. The balance of funds is still low for FY 18, but the balance of funds is in a positive status. Mr. Plunk also discussed projects that have started construction or will be let soon.

Mr. Plunk continued by discussing AOD Truck Traffic Detours. Mr. Plunk said there was an article in the agenda packet that was published in The Anniston Star on April 21<sup>st</sup> for review. The article states that heavy trucks have been rerouted to go down Bynum Leatherwood Rd. instead of entering at the main gate. The traffic has been rerouted until the entrance can be upgraded to handle the larger vehicles. The traffic change is expected to continue until 2020.

Mr. Plunk continued with New Business by calling for the discussion of the MPO Project Priority List. He explained that there was a list in the agenda packet for review and said that the MPO and TAC had reviewed the list, but asked if there were any changes that needed to be done and there were none suggested. He said that the ALDoT had not requested the list be mailed to them at this time, but it was completed if needed.

Next, Mr. Plunk called for ALDoT Status Report on Local Projects. Mr. Shannon T. Jones gave a brief update of the local construction projects, and Mr. Steven Corley gave a brief update on the state construction projects.

There was no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
