The meeting was called to order by MPO Transportation Planner Jack Plunk.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the April 12, 2017, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Anniston/Weaver/J'ville Road project is being closed out at this time and Mr. Plunk stated that there is no updated information available.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Plunk called for review of the FY 16-19 TIP Spreadsheet and MPO projects. Mr. Plunk gave the members a handout of the list of MPO projects to review. All projects highlighted in green have been authorized to move forward by the ALDoT. The projects in yellow are the projects that have been shifted from one FY to another with the additional 1% added to the allocation, projects highlighted in blue have had a recent up or down adjustment in allocation, and the projects highlighted in pink are ATRIP or ARRA funded. Mr. Plunk also discussed projects that have started construction or have been let, and noted that the spreadsheet had been updated for projects under CN even though the contractor may be going through the 90 or 180 day procurement process and the only activity at the project site may be a few CN signs and orange barrels.

Next, Mr. Plunk continued by discussing New Cost Overruns. He asked the members if anyone had any new cost overruns since last meeting. There were none at this time.

Next, Mr. Plunk continued by discussing the Next MPO Projects to be Authorized. He stated that McIntosh Rd. CN for Oxford is in for July, PE for Church St. Resurfacing in Jacksonville for June, Airport Rd. Bridge Replacement PE is also in June, and PE for Russell Dr. Resurfacing in Weaver is June.

Mr. Plunk continued by calling for discussion of Potential for Striping Projects. Mr. Plunk asked the TAC members to explore striping projects which could improve safety and not be too expensive. He mentioned White's Gap Rd. over the mountain as one MPO project completed several years ago, but striping has deteriorated and is almost invisible now.

Next, Mr. Plunk discussed Statewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan Meeting on May 25th 4:00-7:00 p.m. He explained to the members that there was a handout in the agenda packet for review and said that the meeting will be held at the Anniston City Meeting Center - Room A for those that can attend.

Mr. Plunk continued by calling for Status Report on Local ALDoT Projects. Mr. Shannon Jones gave an update on the local construction projects which were provided in the agenda packet for review, and Mr. Steven Corley gave an update on the ALDoT sponsored projects.

There was no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
