The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Mr. Tyler Ferrell.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the February 12, 2020 meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Michael Hosch. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no Old Business to discuss at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Ferrell called for review of the FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. He gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects and reviewed the Administrative Modifications for the month. Mr. Ferrell explained that there was one modification that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and three modifications that did not create any changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Next, Mr. Ferrell called for discussion FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet Adjustments. He stated second handout proposes moving all phases of project #23 64th St. Bridge Replacement to 2024 and 2025, aligning Right of Way and Utilities for the Friendship Road phases (project numbers 48,49, and 50) in the same years, and moving Construction of the Friendship Rd. phase II to 2025. He further explained Construction of project number 23 had been moved to 2024 by ALDOT in the last month or two and notification may not have been sent as it is outside the current TIP. These changes would result in a positive balance throughout this TIP cycle. Calhoun County and Oxford have accepted the changes to their projects and the changes will be requested through the Alexander City office after Resolution 802 passes through the MPO.

Mr. Ferrell then called for discussion of Resolution No. 801. The resolution was requested by the Calhoun Area MPO to amend the FY 2020 UPWP to include unused planning funds from FY 2019. \$121,164 total funds were unused in FY19. He explained there were handouts included in the packet that show the pages that would be revised in the UPWP. \$2,400 would be added to task 3.2 to help facilitate

Public Involvement for the LRTP, \$40,000 would be added to task 5.1 to complete the LRTP, and \$5,000 would be added to task 5.6 to upgrade ITS equipment and software. The remaining \$73,764 would be added to task 6.2 for special studies to be identified and implemented. He advised to please let Libby know if interested in a study for your municipality. The 20% match would then be covered by the municipality requesting the study instead of distributed among all municipalities. If any funds are unspent during FY 20, they can be rolled over for the next 3 years for other special studies, or updates to future documents. A motion was made by Mr. Mark Stephens to approve this request with **Resolution No. 801**, which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.

Mr. Ferrell then called for discussion of Resolution No. 802. The resolution was requested by the Calhoun Area MPO in conjunction with Calhoun County to move the 64th St. Bridge Replacement project Right of Way, Utilities, and Construction to the net TIP to better maintain fiscal constraint. A motion was made by Mr. Mark Stephens this request with **Resolution No. 802**, which was seconded by Mr. Fred Denney. Motion carried.

Next, Mr. Ferrell called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown gave a report included in the agenda packet. He detailed Snow Street was awaiting stripe and punch list items, Bridge painting projects were waiting on punch list items as well, Mountain Street resurfacing supplemental has been approved by the area office, and AL-144 widening will have a pre-construction meeting at the end of March and should start soon.

Next, Mr. Ferrell continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. He asked for any updates to items 1, 6, or 17. For item 1, Mr. Fred Denney and Mr. Shane Brown updated that the lighting agreements had been received by ALDOT and it should be moving along pretty soon. He reported the following updates since the last meeting. For item 13, the information regarding incoming subdivision in the Choccolocco Rd area was given to Skipper for the LRTP. Widening from 431 intersection to the city limits will be added to the LRTP. For item 15, TAP applications are being accepted until the 15th of May. This project could possibly benefit. For item 19, Libby will confirm with CAC next week if this should be 431-exit ramp or Summerall Gate exit ramp. Item 20 is a new observation that signalization is needed at the White's Gap Rd. SR-21 intersection for traffic turning south.

Next, Mr. Ferrell called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She gave the report for the Fixed-Route ridership for the month of February, which was provided in the agenda packet for review. There were 7,262 passengers on the Fixed-Route which was a decrease from the previous month and decrease from the previous year. The final table in the agenda is the ADA Paratransit ridership for the month of January. There were 831 trips for the City of Anniston (decrease), 198 trips for the City of Jacksonville (decrease), 66 trips for the City of Weaver (increase), 192 trips for the City of Oxford (decrease), 167 trips for the Urbanized part of the County (decrease) and 223 trips for the Rural part of the County (decrease).

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:18 a.m.
