The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the April 13, 2022, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the May 11, 2022, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Rodney McCain. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no old business items to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that there were no administrative modifications for the month that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and one administrative modification that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick called for discussion of Resolution No. 836. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was to adopt the new and amended transit performance measures and targets. The FTA Transit State of Good Repair Performance Measures were set by FTA reducing rolling stock of minivans, vans, and cutaway busses by 5% and full size busses by 0%. The Transit Safety Performance Measures were developed by the ACTS staff. There were no incidents in the previous year and their target was set to stay at zero incidents. These targets and performance measures are updated annually. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 836**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown had sent a report for the current construction projects. This report detailed the US-431 access management project was working on punch list items and awaiting final acceptance. The Church Ave resurfacing project is awaiting final acceptance. The I-20 resurfacing project is working on punch list work and awaiting final

acceptance. AL-9 resurfacing is on guardrail installation and bridge rail retrofit. The 431 resurfacing project has had mainline milling completed and placement of the upper binder is scheduled to begin the first week of June.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Mr. Mark Stephens reported on item number 26 that the incoming development is for student housing, and they have met with DOT with the concern for this intersection. Unfortunately, the DOT is not able to do a traffic study with projected numbers and will have to wait to do the traffic study once the student housing development is complete. Mr. Toby Bennington reported that a traffic impact study had been performed for item number 29 prior to the construction.

Next, Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. At the time of the TAC meeting, TAB information had not been received from Anniston Limousine. This information should be included in next week's Policy Committee Meeting.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, July 13, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:13 a.m.

9.2 2045 Visionary Plan

MPOs are required to develop a financial plan to demonstrate how the long-range transportation plan can be implemented. MPOs are obligated to balance the financial costs of the plan projects against expected revenue. This limitation prevents some needed projects from being included in the transportation plan, but it also reduces unrealistic expectations. All projects that could not fit into the transportation plan due to the financial constraints were included in the 2045 Visionary Plan. These projects can be added to the plan by amendment if funding becomes available. The fact that a project is on the Visionary Plan demonstrates the MPO's commitment to the project even though adequate funding is not currently available. The MPO will maintain the visionary plan in the hopes that additional funding will be acquired. The projects that compose the 2045 Visionary Plan are included in Table 9.2 and mapped on Figure 9.4.

Although the projects from the MPO's bicycle and pedestrian plan are not listed, they are considered part of the 2045 Visionary Plan. For a complete listing of these projects, please see the current *Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan of the Calhoun Area*. Excerpts from the plan can be found in Appendix B.

9.2 2045 Visionary Plan

MPOs are required to develop a financial plan to demonstrate how the long-range transportation plan can be implemented. MPOs are obligated to balance the financial costs of the plan projects against expected revenue. This limitation prevents some needed projects from being included in the transportation plan, but it also reduces unrealistic expectations. All projects that could not fit into the transportation plan due to the financial constraints were included in the 2045 Visionary Plan. These projects can be added to the plan by amendment if funding becomes available. The fact that a project is on the Visionary Plan demonstrates the MPO's commitment to the project even though adequate funding is not currently available. The MPO will maintain the visionary plan in the hopes that additional funding will be acquired. The projects that compose the 2045 Visionary Plan are included in Table 9.2 and mapped on Figure 9.4.

Although the projects from the MPO's bicycle and pedestrian plan are not listed, they are considered part of the 2045 Visionary Plan. For a complete listing of these projects, please see the current *Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan of the Calhoun Area*. Excerpts from the plan can be found in Appendix B.
