The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the November 9, 2022, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Fred Denney and was seconded by Mr. Chris Gann.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no old business items to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that there was one administrative modification that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and seven administrative modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 841. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was requested by the City of Anniston to allocate an additional \$149,308 in PE for project #33 (100063226), Chief Ladiga Trail from Cane Creek to 4th Street. The additional funds are requested due to additional Geotech, bridge design, flood study, and trail plans for this project. A motion was made by Mr. Fred Denney to approve this amendment with **Resolution No. 841**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick then called for discussion of Resolution No. 842. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was requested by the ALDOT to allocate an additional \$26,777 in PE for project #45 (100064898), Resurfacing Russell Drive from Peaceburg Rd. to Alexandria Rd. The additional funds are requested due to the original allocation only including the manday amount and did not include any indirect costs from ALDOT. A motion was made by Mr. Mark Stephens to approve this amendment with **Resolution No.** 842, which was seconded by Mr. Chris Gann. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Status Report of Pre-Construction projects. Mr. Michael Burgh reported project #30 had let for 2.7 million; project #41 bridge replacement on Airport Rd at Coldwater creek had been granted an extension from FHWA for PE funding; #48-50 Friendship Rd from Cheaha Dr to Circle Drive all 3 phases will need TS&L, a draft hydraulic study had been submitted and will be reviewed soon; #33 Chief Ladiga Trail will have 30% plans scheduled soon; and 30% plans for #57 Resurfacing on George Douthit had been received and will be reviewed in early January. Mr. Michael Burgh also reported resurfacing on 431 north of 144 would be letting in February of 2023 and resurfacing on 21 from Walmart to the Oxford High School would be let in April of 2023.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown had sent the report included in the agenda packet. US-431 access management and I-20 resurfacing from Snow Creek to the Calhoun/Cleburne County line are both working on punch list items and awaiting final acceptance; US-431 resurfacing from 0.28 miles south of SR 204 to the Etowah County line is on contract for shoulder treatment and awaiting permanent stripe; I-20 resurfacing from H.J. Bentley Jr. Overpass to Snow Creek is awaiting permanent stripe and working on punch list items; and Russell Drive resurfacing and traffic stripe will be pushed to spring due to seasonal limitations, but is awaiting preconstruction conference.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Mr. Mark Stephens reported that the development from item #26 will be going to the planning commission in December. No further updates were available.

Next, Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She reported the handout from the TAB was not available yet, but would be included in the MPO agenda the following week.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, January 11, at 10:00 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:37 a.m.
