After roll call was taken and it was determined that a quorum was present, Chairman Jenkins called the meeting to order at 10:06 a.m.

OLD BUSINESS:

The minutes of the October 19, 2023, meeting was approved on a motion made by Mr. Nick Bowles and seconded by Mr. Toby Bennington. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Jenkins called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick explained that there were eight administrative modifications that created changes to the TIP spreadsheet and no administrative modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Chairman Jenkins then called for a discussion of Resolution No. 860. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was to adopt and support the ALDOT Statewide Performance Measurement Targets: Safety (PM1). She explained this was an annual update and adoption. A motion was made by Mr. Mark Stephens to approve this certification with **Resolution No. 860**, which was seconded by Mr. Chris Gann. Motion carried.

Chairman Jenkins then called for a discussion of Resolution No. 861. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was to amend the 2024 UPWP to add Task 6.4: US-78 Traffic Impact Study. She further explained \$15,000 would be taken from task 5.1 LRTP to create this task. This funding would be replaced when FY23 rollover funds were confirmed. This task would determine how the projected traffic for a proposed development near the intersection of US-78 and National Drive would impact the adjacent roadways and intersections. The City of Anniston will be responsible for the local match for this special project. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this certification with **Resolution No. 861**, which was seconded by Mr. Nick Bowles. Motion carried.

Chairman Jenkins next called for a discussion of CAC Appointments. Ms. Messick reported that there was a list of the members in the agenda packet to review. The City of Anniston needs 9 appointments, 8 for the City of Oxford, and 2 for Jacksonville.

Next, Chairman Jenkins continued with New Business by calling for a discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. There was only one update from item #36 which the county is trying to acquire some backplates for the signal heads to aid in making them stand out from the surroundings. Mr. Rodney McCain further explained that the SR-21 access management will also include signal upgrades and this will be addressed then. Mr. Fred Denney also reported that Mr. DeJarvis Leonard had taken an interest in the Bynum Blvd/Hwy 202 intersection so there may be movement soon on this issue.

Chairman Jenkins next called for a discussion of MPO Boundaries from 2020 Census Data. Maps were provided to show the suggested boundaries from the recent Census as well as current boundaries. Ms. Messick reported the TAC agreed to extend where possible but leave all other boundaries the same.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Chairman Jenkins next called for a discussion of the Status Report of Pre-Construction projects. Mr. Micheal Bergh reported Project 33 will have a meeting on the 17th regarding the bridge and they are hoping for no delays; Project 49's environmental has been approved; Project 50 will have QC this month; Project 57 will have OE submittal this week.

Chairman Jenkins next called for a discussion of the Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown sent an updated report that the reconfiguration of the intersection at US 78 and Barry St has utility conflicts, and US 431 resurfacing from just north of SR-144 to 0.28 miles south of SR-204 just finished RPMS and is waiting on sweeping and acceptance with punch list items.

Chairman Jenkins called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick reported the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 450 (increase) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 131 (decrease) one-way trips, 21 trips for Weaver (increase), and Oxford had 70 (increase) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 95 (increase) one-way trips and

31 (increase) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 7,033 (increase) riders for the month of October.

Finally, Vice Chairman Jenkins called for comments or issues from member jurisdictions or attendees. There were none.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:23 a.m. with a motion to adjourn from Mr. Mark Stephens which was seconded by Mr. Nick Bowles. The next meeting of the MPO will be tentatively Thursday, January 18th at 10:00 a.m.
